OUR PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Reservation and Damage Deposit

A Reservation/Damage deposit of \$250, accompanied by a signed rental contract, confirms your booking. Groups not having returned their contract and Damage Deposit 60 days in advance of their desired date, may lose their reservation if another group requests the same date. This damage deposit is not part of your total fee. The camp withholds the Reservation/Damage Deposit until the damages (if any) have been assessed and paid. The amount remaining or owing will then be refunded or charged.

Payment Schedule / Billing

Your group will be billed using the confirmed number of participants you provide our office with, a minimum of two weeks prior to your rental dates. In the event that your group is larger than what was confirmed, your bill will increase according.

Cancellations

If cancellation takes place within 60 days of your retreat/event date and is due to reasons other than weather, your group will be charged the expected income of your group or of another group if one wished to book during the same time as your group. If cancellation is outside the 60 days your deposit may be transferable to another date if the event is rescheduled for a time in the same calendar year. Otherwise it is not transferable. If cancellation is due to weather conditions, we will try to reschedule your booking. If rescheduling is not possible, you will receive a full refund of your deposit.

Future Reservation Requests

Consideration is given to those groups that have used our camp on a consistent basis. If you would like to book again with The Pembina Valley Bible Camp prior to leaving, please discuss the transferring of your deposit with the host. Every effort will be made to accommodate your group for the time slot requested.

SCHEDULE CONSIDERATIONS

- ◆ Most of the activities (horses, archery, climbing tower) need at least 75 minutes to run properly.
- ◆ Tentative schedules are to be submitted two weeks prior to the event. If we have not received your schedule then we cannot guarantee the availability of the activities.
- ◆ Pembina Valley Bible Camp reserves the right to review and revise the proposed schedule as needed.
- ◆ Because of the size of the camp and the various purposes for which groups use our site, we reserve the right to book multiple groups. In the event of multiple booking (more than one guest group at a time) we will develop the schedule giving priority to the first confirmed group.
- ◆ If the camp is providing food service, then breakfast will be anytime between 8:00am and 9:00am, lunch between 12:00noon and 1:00pm, and supper between 5:00pm and 6:00pm. We request that all retreaters be at all meals to reduce wasted food. (meal times may be subject to change)

Gratis Work

- ◆ In an effort to keep costs relatively inexpensive for you, we do not hire people to clean up after rental groups. If using the cabins and/or dining hall, you will be asked to clean the cabins, and the dining hall before leaving, stack the chairs and tables, clean tables, and clean washing area.
- ◆ The group will also be responsible for the washing of the dishes after each meal.

Statement of faith and life

Scripture

Please Inform All Retreaters

We offer our services and facilities to our guests for their enjoyment and inspiration towards growth. As a Christian camp we must remain true to our Statement of Faith and Life, our Mission Statement, and our Code of Conduct. We require that all individuals or groups who attend or visit our site either support, or at minimum, are not opposed and/or contravene them. Therefore the Camp has outlined a Code of Conduct that requires all groups and individuals to follow and adhere to.

The **Guest Group Contact Person** is responsible to inform the group regarding the Code of Conduct before you come to camp. This will alleviate any mishaps between the time that you arrive and the time that you would be able to go over these guidelines. **Please take note that our staff serve as merely a supplement to, rather than a substitution for, adult supervision of children and youth.**

While on the Pembina Valley Bible Camp site all guests and visitors shall refrain from the following:

- ◆ Adherence to or participation in religious practices contrary to or not in accordance with the Statement of Faith.
- ◆ Promoting or engaging in pre-marital or extra marital sexual relationships.
- ◆ Reading or viewing pornographic material in media such as, but not limited to, videos, magazines, and music.
- ◆ Sexual and general harassment and abuse.
- ◆ Engaging in homosexual activity, including support of any homosexual organizations, or expression of viewpoints supporting homosexuality of any kind as interpreted by the Board or the Director.
- ◆ Engaging in racist conduct or supporting racist viewpoints.
- ◆ Support of or participation in abortion or abortion related viewpoints.
- ◆ Smoking is discouraged and is allowed in designated areas only. Please consult with the Director as to designated areas.
- ◆ Possession of liquor or non-medical drugs is prohibited on the property.
- ◆ Foul or blasphemous language is not tolerated.

Pembina Valley Bible Camp reserves the right to exclude or terminate the stay of organizations, groups or individuals whose goals, values, objectives or philosophy are in the opinion of the Board of Directors and/or management of the Camp opposed and /or contrary to, the Statement of Faith, Mission and Code of Conduct of the Camp. The interpretation of the provisions of this Code of Conduct shall be the sole prerogative of the Board of Directors and management of the Pembina Valley Bible Camp and Retreat Centre.
